## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Friday, March 6, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

<b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b>	<i>There are no public warnings in effect at this time. A <b>Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots)</b> remains in effect for the Southeast Bahamas. <b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>A broad surface ridge will continue to steer locally strong winds and showers across the Bahamas throughout the period, as it remains the dominant weather feature for this evening. An influx of low to mid-level moisture will gradually make its way into portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas overnight into Saturday, increasing the likelihood of showers and thunderstorms in these areas.</p> <p><b>Outlook:</b> Windy conditions with quick passing showers will continue across the Bahamas due to a strong surface ridge, as a wet weather pattern persists mainly across portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas into next week. A weak mid-level disturbance may develop over the region early in the work week, bringing the potential for severe weather and localized flooding across the southern half of the country. These precipitation chances will drop off by midweek, as high pressure and a drier air mass filters into the Bahamas once again.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b>Flooding:</b> There is a <b>marginal risk</b> of flooding, mainly in low-lying and flood-prone areas, across portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas on Saturday. <i>The public is urged to exercise caution in these areas, especially during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.</i></p> <p><b>Rip Currents and Rough Surf:</b> There is a <b>moderate to high risk</b> of rip currents for all areas. <i>Beachgoers are strongly advised to refrain from entering the water in the Southeast Bahamas and Atlantic coastal waters and due to elevated seas and life-threatening surf conditions driven by moderate to strong winds.</i></p>
