



# BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Friday, June 12, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.**

High pressure ridging will remain in place across most of the island chain through Saturday, with some weak surface troughing lingering across the Central and Southeastern Bahamas. This ridging pattern will continue to maintain generally stable conditions across the region, although strong daytime heating may trigger some isolated showers or a possible isolated thunderstorm during the afternoon hours on Saturday, especially across the Southeastern islands as a tropical wave moving westward across the Caribbean sea amplifies troughing across that area. Meanwhile, gentle to moderate breezes will continue to prevail through Saturday.

**GENERAL SITUATION:**

**Outlook:** This tropical wave will introduce locally brisk winds while gradually increasing cloud cover and the likelihood of showers and thunderstorms, particularly across the southern portions of the island chain through the weekend. As the wave progresses westward, lingering moisture will gradually spread northward, bringing an increased chance of showers to the northern islands early in the work week. This moisture is expected to pool ahead of a frontal boundary forecast to approach northern Florida by late next week, helping to maintain humid and unsettled conditions across the region.

**Heat and UV Index:** Members of the public across **The Bahamas** are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** range and heat indices may reach the **lower triple digits**.

**SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:**

**Rip Currents:** A **slight** risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed beaches of the island chain. **Beachgoers should exercise caution when entering the water.**

**Coastal Flooding:** As a result of the approaching New Moon cycle (Sunday 14<sup>th</sup>), coastal residents are advised that there is a **marginal risk** of coastal flooding during **evening high tides** through to next week Thursday.

**Disorganized shower and thunderstorm activity near a broad area of low pressure located over the Bay of Campeche. Environmental conditions are forecast to be only marginally conducive for development before the system moves inland over eastern Mexico late Saturday or Sunday....Formation chance through 7 days...low...20 percent.**

**SKY CONDITIONS:** **Northern Bahamas:** Mostly sunny, turning mostly fair at night.  
**Northwest and Central Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.

**PRECIPITATION:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 10 to 30% chance of showers.  
**Central Bahamas:** 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of shower with an isolated afternoon thunderstorm

**WINDS:** **Northern Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.  
**Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less.
