BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Friday, July 18, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time. A Near Gale warning remains in effect for the territorial waters of Inagua until sunrise on Saturday. Please see additional information on our Marine Forecast at met.gov.bs.
GENERAL SITUATION:	Decreasing winds, warmer temperatures and an uneventful weather pattern will persist tonight through to Saturday, as the sub-tropical Atlantic high pressure ridge continues to be the main driver of prevailing weather conditions across the Bahamas. <i>Outlook:</i> The summertime pattern for the remainder of this upcoming weekend will be briefly interrupted by a mid to upper-level disturbance that will move westwards across the Bahamas beginning on Monday. This system will allow for cloudy conditions and slightly higher shower chances for the first half of the work-week. A significantly drier air mass will reintroduce relatively hot and hazy conditions to close out the remainder of the week.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Rip Currents: There remains a moderate to high risk of rip currents affecting all eastern, southern and Atlantic beaches. Beachgoers in the Central and Southeast Bahamas are urged to remain onshore, and should exercise extreme caution in the Northern and Northwest Bahamas in these areas. Heat/UV Index: Residents and visitors are advised to remain hydrated, wear light colored clothing and to take frequent breaks during hours of peak heating on Saturday, as UV indices are expected to be in the high to very high range and heat indices are expected in the upper 90's to the low to mid triple digits into the weekend.
