BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Friday, July 24, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT: *There are currently no warnings in effect at this time.*

GENERAL SITUATION:

The Northern and Northwest Bahamas will continue to see higher chances for showers and thunderstorms through Saturday as tropical moistures lingers near an upper-level disturbance. Winds will stay moderate to fresh across most islands, but become lighter across the Northern Bahamas on Saturday as the pressure pattern relaxes across that area.

Outlook: By Sunday, an approaching frontal boundary will increase the risk of strong to severe thunderstorms over the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. As this system lingers near the islands through the middle of next week, repeated rounds of heavy showers and thunderstorms could lead to localized flooding, especially across the northern islands. Meanwhile, high pressure will keep the Central and Southeast Bahamas mostly warm, dry, and hazy through early next week, with another plume of Saharan dust limiting shower activity. By late Tuesday, a strong tropical wave is expected to move into the southern Bahamas, increasing the chance of showers and thunderstorms across the Central and Southeast Bahamas through Thursday.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Severe Weather Risk: There is a *moderate* risk for isolated strong to severe thunderstorms, particularly across the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas** today. The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

Flooding: There is a *marginal* to *moderate* risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas, mainly across the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas**, especially during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.

Rip Currents: There is a *moderate* to *high* risk of rip currents for Atlantic-exposed waters and southeast coastal waters of the archipelago. *Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to avoid entering waters of the Southeast Bahamas. Swimmers ought not to venture into waters where they cannot comfortably stand.*

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly to variably cloudy tonight, becoming a mix of sun and clouds tomorrow.		
PRECIPITATION:	30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms through tomorrow		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots through tomorrow morning, falling to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy tonight, becoming a mix of sun and clouds tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots through tomorrow morning, falling to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly fair tonight, becoming partly sunny tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts through tomorrow.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 92°F / 32°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 100°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: Tropical cyclone activity is not expected during the next 7 days.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 26TH JULY 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern Bahamas: Partly cloudy.
Northwest Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny and hazy, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 40 to 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 100°F / 36°C – 38°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 27TH JULY 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern Bahamas: Cloudy to overcast.
Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny and hazy, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 50 to 70% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, shifting southwest to west at 10 knots, falling light and variable at times by the afternoon.
Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the evening.
Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts during the morning hours, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing to 15 knots by nightfall.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 82°F – 91°F / 28°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 100°F / 36°C – 38°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY 28TH JULY 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern Bahamas: Cloudy to overcast.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.
Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy.

PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 40 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers.
Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots by the evening hours.

WINDS: Northwest and Central Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots by nightfall.

WINDS: Northwest and Central Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

Elsewhere: 10 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 to 20 knots by the evening hours

WINDS: Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less
Central Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots through the morning hours, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours.
Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots
