BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Friday, September 25, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

Boaters in the Northern and Northwest Bahamas are strongly advised to not enter Atlantic and Gulf stream waters. For a complete Marine report, see the Marine Forecast at www.met.gov.bs

A slow-moving, weak cold front across the Northwest Bahamas continues to move southeastward. Ahead of the front, showers and thunderstorms will affect mainly the Central and Southeast Bahamas, while areas behind the front will experience drier and more stable conditions.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The frontal boundary is expected to become stationary near the Central Bahamas tomorrow, bringing cloudy skies, showers, and isolated thunderstorms through the weekend. Meanwhile, the Northern and Northwestern Bahamas can expect mostly pleasant and stable conditions. By Monday, most of the moisture is expected to move out of the area, resulting in a sunny and warm day. However, unsettled weather is expected to return by Tuesday and persist through much of the work week as troughing interacts with a tropical wave.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: There is a **slight to moderate** risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms **across** portions of the **Central and Southeast Bahamas tomorrow**. These storms could produce **strong gusty winds**, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and **waterspout activity**. Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

Rip Currents: There is a **high** risk of hazardous rip currents and rough surf over the **Atlantic waters of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas**, while a **slight to moderate** risk exists along Atlantic beaches of the Central & Southeast Bahamas. **Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly urged to refrain from entering Gulf stream and Atlantic exposed waters in the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, and should continue to exercise caution elsewhere.**

**TROPICAL
WEATHER
OUTLOOK:**

Tropical Storm Fay located 29.8N and 43.0W or 1075 miles west-southwest of the Azores. Maximum sustained winds are 50 mph and is moving west-southwest at 5 mph. Gradual weakening is expected to occur for the next few days.

Newly formed **Tropical Storm Gonzalo**, located 16.2N 22.7W or 35 miles south-southeast of Sal Cabo Verde. Maximum sustained winds at 50 mph and present movement is north at 12 mph. Gonzalo is forecast to become a post-tropical remnant low by Sunday.

Neither of these systems poses a threat to the Bahamas.
Elsewhere, tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven days.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly sunny at first, becoming a mix of sun and clouds by the afternoon. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers. Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with a slight chance of a few isolated afternoon thunderstorms. Central & Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 40% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Northwest to north at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times. Central Bahamas: West to northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times. Southeast Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable by the evening hours.
