BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Friday, June 5, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

**WARNING
IN EFFECT:**

A Quasi-stationary frontal boundary remains draped across the Central Bahamas. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms are occurring ahead and behind the front, being fueled by moisture from the Gulf. High pressure north of the country is supporting a dryer airmass that is attempting to enter the Northern islands that will result in pops of sunshine across the Northern and Northwest islands tomorrow.

**GENERAL
SITUATION:**

Outlook: For the remainder of the weekend, ample moisture, the remnants of the front and a weak mid-level disturbance will maintain a wet weather pattern across the Central and Southeast Bahamas, with the dry air mass acting as a buffer for the northern territories for the majority of the period. The disturbance will gradually migrate northwards, possibly increasing shower and thunderstorm chances over portions of the Northwest Bahamas beginning on Sunday. Heading into next week, weak high pressure will gradually build southwards into the Bahamas, creating patchy, cloudy periods of shallow topped showers and occasionally brisk breezes.

Severe Weather Potential: There is a *moderate* risk of the development of a few strong to severe thunderstorms over **Central and the Southeast Bahamas** in the vicinity of the front. *The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

NOTES:**

Flooding: There is a *marginal* to *moderate* risk of flooding in the **Central and the Southeast Bahamas** during heavy and prolonged rainfall events. *Residents should monitor conditions and are urged to exercise caution when traversing in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during such events.*

Rip Currents: There remains a *moderate* risk of rip currents in Atlantic waters of the Bahamas. *Beachgoers and swimmers are urged to exercise caution.*

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Fair to partly cloudy to night, partly sunny tomorrow.

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or an afternoon thunderstorm

WINDS: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots.

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or an afternoon thunderstorm.

WINDS: Northeast to east at 15 knots tonight, becoming easterly at 10 to 15 knots tomorrow

WINDS: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots tonight, becoming east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots falling light and variable at times.

PRECIPITATION: 30 to 50% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots falling light and variable at times.

Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Northern Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.
PRECIPITATION: **Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas:** 20 – 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
WINDS: **Southeast Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times during the day, shifting east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 knots or less, increasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.
WINDS: **Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
82°F – 90°F / 28°C – 32°C 72°F – 79°F / 22°C – 26°C 93°F – 98°F / 34°C – 37°C

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
WINDS: **Central Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 knots by nightfall
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.

WINDS: **Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with occasionally higher gusts.

WINDS: **Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with occasionally higher gusts.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 to 40% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or an afternoon thunderstorm.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, veering northeast by evening.
