BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Friday, August 28, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT: *A **Heat Advisory** remains in effect for the Central & Southeast Bahamas as well as the Turks and Caicos Islands.*

A tropical wave along with Atlantic troughing are being enhanced by an upper level low in the western Bahamas, producing showers and thunderstorms in the Northwest and Central Islands through tomorrow. A broad high pressure system is supporting moderate to fresh winds and moderate seas over islands.

GENERAL SITUATION: ***Outlook:** Sunday, a frontal boundary is forecast to move near the southern United States, with associated pre-frontal activity bringing another increase in showers and thunderstorms across the Northern Bahamas. Heading into the work week, another surge of moisture may affect all areas, increasing the potential for flooding and severe weather through the remainder of the week.*

Rip Currents:** There is a **slight** to **moderate** risk of rip currents affecting the eastern and southern shorelines of the **Bahamas**. **Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to exercise caution when entering the water.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: ***UV Index:** Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **high** to **extreme** range.*

***Severe Weather Potential:** There is the potential for severe weather across the Northern Bahamas tomorrow afternoon. Thunderstorms can be sever and rain can become heavy inducing flooding in low lying areas. There is also a marginal chance of a funnel cloud.*

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy tonight through tomorrow afternoon when skies become cloudy to overcast.

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 30% chance of isolated showers or a thunderstorm tonight and tomorrow, becoming 40 to 60% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorm in the afternoon.

WINDS: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots tonight, veering east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots tomorrow.

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 30% chance of showers tonight increasing 20 to 30% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms tomorrow.

WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots but gusty at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, with occasional gusts.

Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots falling light and variable at times.
