BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Friday, August 7, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT: *No public warnings in effect.*

Troughing continues to support streaming showers and isolated thunderstorm activity while shift westwards through tonight. Moderate to locally fresh winds will continue over The Bahamas, with high pressure ridging progressively building in on Saturday.

GENERAL SITUATION:

OUTLOOK: More stable weather will gradually return over the weekend and into midweek as high pressure strengthens and deep tropical moisture pulls away from the island chain. As a result, shower and thunderstorm activity is expected to decrease across much of the country, although a few isolated showers and thunderstorms may still develop across the Northern Bahamas where pockets of moisture still linger. By Thursday, a tropical wave moving in from the east is expected to approach the Southeast Bahamas, bringing an increase in showers and thunderstorms across those islands as it continues to trek westward.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: *There is a moderate risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas tonight.* These storms are capable of producing *strong gusty winds*, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and *waterspout activity*. *Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: There is a moderate risk of rip currents for the Atlantic coastal waters of the Bahamas archipelago and east and southeast sheltered coastal waters of parts of the Central and the entire Southeast Bahamas.

UV Index: On Saturday, members of the public are still advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (11am – 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the very high to extreme range.

PRECIPITATION:	10 to 30% chance of streaming showers with the chance of an isolated thunderstorm.		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with occasionally higher gusts.

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of streaming showers.
WINDS: Easterly at 15 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: MINIMUM: 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C MAXIMUM: 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C HEAT INDEX: 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of streaming showers.
WINDS: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, with occasional gusts.
TEMPERATURES: MINIMUM: 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C MAXIMUM: 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C HEAT INDEX: 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: Tropical cyclone activity is not expected through the next 7 days.

WINDS: Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: MAXIMUM: 86°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C MINIMUM: 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C HEAT INDEX: 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 10TH AUGUST, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly sunny to sunny
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20-30% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or a thunderstorm
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon.
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: MAXIMUM: 86°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C MINIMUM: 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C HEAT INDEX: 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY 11TH AUGUST, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: A mix of sun and clouds.
PRECIPITATION: All Areas: 10 to 30% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less.
Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the evening.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: MAXIMUM: 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C MINIMUM: 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C HEAT INDEX: 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the afternoon hours

WINDS: **Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots by the evening.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
