BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Monday, January 12, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A weak cold front sits just north of the Capital this afternoon with a few isolated showers behind the boundary. Meanwhile, weak low-level troughing will support some shower activity over portions of the Southeast Bahamas overnight into tomorrow.</p> <p>Outlook: The front is expected to stall and gradually dissipate near the Northwest Bahamas through tomorrow. On Wednesday, prefrontal troughing associated with another approaching cold front will generate scattered showers across the northern islands, while lingering troughing supports a few light showers over parts of the Central and Northwest Bahamas. By early Thursday, the cold front is forecast to move into the area and progress through the archipelago, bringing increased shower activity and the potential for thunderstorms through the end of the work week. In its wake, much cooler temperatures are expected, along with strong winds and building seas as high pressure settles in behind the front, leading to rough marine conditions into the weekend.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Rip Currents: There is a moderate to high risk of rip currents along all Atlantic-exposed shorelines. Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to exercise extreme caution when entering these waters.</p>

SKY CONDITIONS:	Mostly fair, with a few cloudy intervals tonight, with a mix of sun and clouds expected tomorrow.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 % chance of a few isolated showers later tonight into the overnight hours, increasing to a 30 – 40% chance of showers by tomorrow afternoon.		
WINDS:	Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots tonight with higher gusts possible at times, shifting east-northeast to east-southeast tomorrow.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR: THURSDAY 15 TH , JANUARY 2026.			
SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Cloudy. Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: South to southwest at 15 knots at first, veering southwest to west at 15 to 25 knots by the afternoon hours. Expect winds to shift west to northwest at 20 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale immediately behind the front by nightfall. Southeast Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, veering Southwest to West at 10 to 15 knots, by the afternoon hours. Expect winds to become light and variable at times by nightfall.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Mostly sunny, turning fair at night. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy, with gradual clearing throughout the day.		
PRECIPITATION:	All Areas: 10 – 30% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: Northwest to north at 15 to 25 knots, veering north to northeast at 10 to 15 knots, with higher winds immediately behind the front. Southeast Bahamas: West to northwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times, veering north to northeast at 15 knots as the front moves into the area.
