BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, July 14, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There are no public warnings in effect at this time.
GENERAL SITUATION:	An area of low pressure north of the Bahamas coupled with ample tropical moisture and aided by upper level support will continue to trigger bouts of showers with embedded thunderstorms mainly across the Northwest and portions of the Central Bahamas. Surface high pressure will dominate the remainder of the islands. <i>Outlook:</i> The aforementioned low is expected to cross the Florida peninsula and enter the Gulf of Mexico Tuesday where it will be closely watched for possible tropical development over the next few days. Regardless of development, expect continued showers and thunderstorms across mostly the Northwest Bahamas. In the meantime, high pressure will build across the Bahamas through the period.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Severe Thunderstorm Potential: Instances of heavy rainfall, severe thunderstorms and other hazards, such as tornadic/waterspout activity, hail and gusty winds, may occur in isolated instances in the Northern Bahamas. All residents are urged to remain vigilant of the current weather conditions and to keep updated on all severe thunderstorm warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology. <i>Flooding:</i> There is an elevated risk of flooding across all areas during heavy and prolonged rainfall events, especially the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas through to Tuesday. Low- lying, flood-prone and urban areas are particularly at risk.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:	Disorganized showers and thunderstorms offshore the east coast of Florida are associated with an area of low pressure. Over the next day or so, the disturbance is forecast to move westward, entering the northeast Gulf of Mexico by late Tuesday. Some gradual development is possible during the middle to late part of the week as the system moves westward to northwestward across the northeast and north-central Gulf of Mexico. This system has a low chance (30%) of formation through seven days. Elsewhere, tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven (7) days.
