BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Monday, December 22, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	A Wind Advisory and Gale Warning is in effect for the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas. Please see more information in our Marine Forecast at our website @ met.gov.bs.
GENERAL SITUATION:	A cold front across the Central Bahamas will support a few passing showers along its boundary as it quickly pushes southeastwards and into the Southeast Bahamas tonight through tomorrow. Strong high pressure building behind the advancing front will generate fresh to strong northeast to east breezes across the chain of islands through the next few days. **Outlook:* Dangerous beaching and boating conditions are expected to persist through the remainder of the week due to strong winds and lingering swell conditions. The aforementioned front will move into the southeast Bahamas late Tuesday into Wednesday, bringing a few showers to the area before exiting late Wednesday. Another weak reinforcing front, accompanied by a drier air mass, is forecast to move into the region during the Christmas and Boxing Day holidays with little impact, keeping rain chances very low through the latter part of the week.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Wind Hazards: As a result of wind gusts possibly exceeding 35 miles per hour, residents across all areas are urged to secure or tie down relatively light loose objects in their yards, and to drive carefully, especially along roads along northern and eastern shorelines. Rip Currents/High and Rough Surf: There is a high risk of life threatening rip currents, high seas and rough surf conditions impacting northern, eastern and Atlantic-facing shorelines. Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to refrain from entering the waters in these areas. Coastal Hazards: There is a risk of minor coastal flooding and beach erosion along northern and eastern coastal areas. Large, overtopping waves and windblown sand is likely, and can prove hazardous to motorists and pedestrians. Therefore, it is advised that extreme caution is exercised while traversing these areas, especially the Glass Window Bridge in Eleuthera beginning this evening.
