BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Monday, January 26, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<i>A Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots) will come into effect for the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas tonight and through noon on Wednesday. Occasional gusts to gale force are possible across the mentioned areas. Boaters, especially small craft, are urged to return to and remain in port until further notice.</i>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>Prefrontal activity along with a strong cold front across the Northwest Bahamas will quickly push southeastwards tonight and into the Central Bahamas tomorrow and the Southeast Bahamas by Wednesday. Winds will quickly freshen behind the front tonight as strong high pressure builds across the area with occasional wind gusts to near gale force expected. A cold and dry airmass will spread across the islands through the period.</p> <p>Outlook: Moderate to strong winds with gusts to near gale force will commence in the Northern Islands tonight then spread into the Northwest and Central islands on Tuesday and Wednesday, respectively. This cold front will generate another round of cooler temperatures through midweek before stalling just north of the Southeast Bahamas. A reinforcing front will quickly follow by early Thursday morning, eventually merging with the previous front and exit the country that evening. This will allow temperatures to dip towards more comfortable values across all areas by the end of the work week.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Rip Currents: There is a high risk of life-threatening rip currents on the open and Atlantic waters of the island chain, during this week. Beachgoers are advised to refrain from entering these waters.</p> <p>Coastal Hazards: Motorists and pedestrians are advised to exercise extreme caution while traversing coastal roads, along sea walls and The Glass Window Bridge on the Island of Eleuthera as waves can cause coastal flooding, erosion, deposit debris onto the roadway and pull pedestrians into the sea.</p>

PRECIPITATION:	Central Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers. Northern, Northwest and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 knots with occasionally higher gusts, decreasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall. Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 to 25 knots, decreasing 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts by nightfall. Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times at night.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern Bahamas: Mostly cloudy during the day, turning mostly fair at night. Northwest and Central Bahamas: Cloudy to occasionally overcast. Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds during the day, turning mostly cloudy at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10% chance of showers. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: Northwest to North at 15 to 25 knots after the frontal passage. Southeast Bahamas: West to Northwest at 15 knots, veering North to Northeast at 15 to 25 knots after the passage of the front by nightfall.

WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: West to Northwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times, veering Northwest to North at 20 to 25 knots with higher gusts after the frontal passage. Central Bahamas: North-northwest to north-northeast at 10 to 15 knots, veering northwesterly at 15 to 20 knots by the early evening. Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times ahead of the front, becoming northerly at 15 to 20 knots by nightfall behind the front.
