BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, September 28, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING EFFECT: IN *There are no public warnings in effect at this time.*

A decayed frontal boundary over the Northwest Bahamas, combined with an upper-level trough streaming tropical moisture across the region, is supporting widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms, particularly across the Northwest and parts of the Central Bahamas. On Tuesday, troughing will shift northward as a weak low-level circulation may develop near the Northern Bahamas, bringing periods of unsettled weather to the northern half of the country. Light to gentle breezes are expected in the north, with gentle to moderate breezes elsewhere.

GENERAL SITUATION: *Outlook:* Cloudy skies will persist across the country through much of the workweek as a strengthening mid- to upper-level trough continues to transport abundant tropical moisture across the Bahamas. **These features will support additional rounds of unsettled weather, including heavy showers and isolated severe thunderstorms capable of producing flash flooding and dangerous lightning.** Beginning late Wednesday, winds are also expected to increase, becoming fresh to locally strong across the Bahamas through Friday. By Saturday, conditions should gradually improve as high pressure builds and a relatively drier air mass moves into the region, although a few isolated showers may persist.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: **Severe Thunderstorm Risk:** There is a *moderate to high* risk for a few strong isolated to severe thunderstorms across **portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas on Tuesday**. These storms could produce strong gusty winds, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and waterspout activity. *Residents and visitors should monitor for the issuance of any severe weather watches or warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

Rip Currents: There is a *moderate to high* risk of hazardous rip currents and rough surf across all Atlantic waters. *Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly urged to refrain from entering Gulf Stream and Atlantic-exposed waters and should continue to exercise caution elsewhere.*

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy tonight, becoming partly cloudy to cloudy tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 10 – 20% chance of an isolated shower or two tonight, increasing to a 30 – 50% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms on Tuesday. *Some showers may become heavy and thunderstorms strong to severe at times.*
WINDS: Variable at 10 knots or less tonight, increasing to south to southwest tomorrow at 10 knots with occasional higher gusts by the afternoon hours, *especially in heavy showers or thunderstorms.*
