BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, August 31, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has issued a Special Weather Statement regarding the remnants of Dolly and the potential for inclement weather conditions across The Bahamas during the upcoming week. For the full statement and latest information, please visit our website: met.gov.bs

Lingering troughing interacting with abundant tropical moisture will continue to support cloudy skies and elevated shower and thunderstorm chances across the Northern Bahamas tonight through tomorrow. Meanwhile, the remnants of Dolly will bring increasing moisture and shower activity to Southeast Bahamas overnight into Tuesday morning, with associated weather expected to spread into the Central Bahamas by the afternoon and evening.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Through mid-week, the presence of a westward moving tropical wave and its associated moisture will produce an increased risk of flooding and severe weather conditions, as a wet and unsettled weather pattern continues across the archipelagic chain (*See Special Weather Statement*). By the end of the work week, drier conditions will return as high pressure ridging builds across the country. On Sunday, A cold front will move off the eastern US coastline, introducing pre-frontal conditions across the northern territories.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: *There is a slight to moderate risk for isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of the Northern, Northwest and Southeast Bahamas this evening and tomorrow.* These storms are capable of producing **strong gusty winds**, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and **waterspout activity**. *Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flood Risk: There is a **slight to moderate** risk for flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall periods, especially over portions of the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas**.

Rip Currents: A **high risk** of rip currents exists along **eastern and southern shorelines of the Southeast Bahamas**, while a **slight to moderate** risk persists elsewhere. *Beachgoers and swimmers in the Southeast Bahamas are strongly advised to refrain from entering the water, while those elsewhere should exercise caution when entering the water.*

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly cloudy to cloudy through tomorrow.		
PRECIPITATION:	40 to 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 knots or less through tomorrow morning, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the afternoon hours tomorrow and northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots by the evening.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy tonight, becoming partly cloudy tomorrow

PRECIPITATION: 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms through tomorrow morning, increasing to a 50 to 60% chance by the afternoon

WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots through tomorrow morning, falling to less than 10 knots by the afternoon. Becoming easterly at 10 to 15 knots by the evening hours.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly fair tonight, becoming a mix of sun and clouds tomorrow with increasing cloudiness through the afternoon to evening hours.

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of showers with the chance of an isolated thunderstorm increasing to 30 to 50% by the afternoon hours.

WINDS: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts.

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy tonight, becoming partly cloudy to cloudy tomorrow, with decreasing cloudiness through the evening hours.

PRECIPITATION: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms decreasing to 20 to 30% by the late afternoon through evening hours

WINDS: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

Near Hispaniola (Remnants of Dolly):
A surface trough of low pressure (the remnants of Tropical Storm Dolly) is producing disorganized showers and thunderstorms near and over portions of Hispaniola, Turks and Caicos, and the southeastern Bahamas. Formation chance through 7 days is low at near 0 percent.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 02ND SEPTEMBER, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Cloudy to occasionally overcast.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Variably to partly cloudy

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 40 to 70% chance of showers with thunderstorms. *Showers can become heavy at times and thunderstorms strong to severe.*
Central Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers and thunderstorms
Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated afternoon thunderstorms

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

Elsewhere: 20 to 30% chance of showers.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots, gusty at times.

PRECIPITATION: Elsewhere: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less.
Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.

WINDS: Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, becoming gusty at times in the Southeast Bahamas.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

Central Bahamas: Southeasterly at less than 10 knots, falling light and variable by the afternoon hours

WINDS: Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the afternoon.
