BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, September 7, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A **Severe Weather Watch** remains in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. For marine forecasts and our other products please see our webpage: met.gov.bs

An area of low pressure is deepening just west of Grand Bahama, along with deep troughing, ahead of a frontal boundary, will support continued showers and thunderstorms across the North and Northwest Bahamas through tomorrow. In the Southeast Bahamas tropical moisture along with a weak surface trough will increase shower activity in the area overnight and early morning. Elsewhere high pressure ridge is supporting light to gentle winds and slight seas, both will increase and build tomorrow as the high begins to shift westward.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Weather conditions should gradually improve by Wednesday into early Thursday as the boundary lifts northward and the low shifts to the west, allowing ridging to rebuild across the country. Afternoon showers and thunderstorms still remain possible, as a summer-time weather pattern returns, and moisture continues to stream across the island chain. However, by Saturday, shower and thunderstorm chances once again are forecasted to increase when another frontal boundary dips into the Southeastern US, resulting in troughing across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, before merging with troughing associated with a wave across the Central Bahamas on Sunday.

Flood Risk: There is a **slight** to **moderate** risk for flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall periods, especially over portions of the **Northern Bahamas and Northwest Bahamas**.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

UV Index: Members of the public across the **Central & Southeast Bahamas** are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **high** range.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Cloudy to occasionally overcast through tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 40% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms tonight increasing 40 to 70% chance of scattered showers and thunderstorms tomorrow.
WINDS: Southerly at 10 knots or less tonight, becoming east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times tomorrow.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27° C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy through tomorrow
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 40% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms tonight increasing 40 to 70% chance of scattered showers and thunderstorms tomorrow.
WINDS: Southeast at 10 knots or less tonight, becoming east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots tomorrow.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27° C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A



CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Fair to partly cloudy tonight, becoming a mix of sun and clouds tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 10 to 30% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms through tomorrow.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less tonight, increasing 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times tomorrow.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy tonight, variably cloudy tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms through tomorrow.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less tonight, increasing 10 to 15 knots tomorrow
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: The tropics remain quiet this afternoon and tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven (7) days.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 9TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Southeast Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.
Elsewhere: Partly cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, becoming 10 knots or less across the Northern Bahamas by the evening hours.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, increasing to 15 to 20 knots during the overnight hours.
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 10TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **All Areas:** A mix of sun and clouds
PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots during the morning hours, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon.
Northwest Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

	Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.		
	Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 to 20 knots by the evening.
