BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, September 21, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time.

An abundance of tropical moisture along with deep layered troughing and an upper level disturbance will continue to support showers and thunderstorms across the Bahamas through tomorrow. A weak pressure pattern continue to support gentle trade winds throughout the country.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The upper low will drift northward, allowing a ridge to gradually build into the area. This will reduce the potential for severe weather, while cloudy and wet conditions persist through mid-week, as a continuous stream of abundant tropical moisture moves across the country. Shower and thunderstorm chances are expected to **increase** slightly across the northern territories by early Thursday, as a weak **cold** front approaches the area before gradually crossing the Northern Bahamas on Friday. The front is expected to stall across the region thereafter, allowing a drier and more stable airmass to filter into the northern islands by the weekend.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: *There is a **slight to moderate** risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms **across** portions of the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas** (this afternoon through tonight). These storms could produce **strong gusty winds**, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and **waterspout** activity. Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flooding: There is a **slight to moderate** risk of flooding in low-lying and flood-prone areas during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.

Rip Currents: There is a **slight** risk of rip currents impacting the eastern and southern shorelines of the Southeast Bahamas. *Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to exercise caution.*
