



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, July 27, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

A **Severe Weather Watch** remains in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

A **Dust Advisory** remains in effect for the Southeast Bahamas and the Turks and Caicos Islands. Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

Prefrontal troughing, extending from a front well north of The Bahamas, coupled with ample tropical moisture, continues to produce bouts of unsettled weather over the northern territories late tonight into Tuesday morning. Meanwhile, high pressure ridging and Saharan dust will continue to limit shower activity and produce hazy skies over the southern half of the country.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The Northern and Northwest Bahamas will continue to see the highest chances of showers and thunderstorms through midweek due to a lingering frontal boundary across the southeast US. The Central and Southeast Bahamas is expected to remain more stable, warmer and hazier under the influence of the plume of Saharan dust that is expected to remain across that area through Wednesday. A tropical wave could briefly increase shower chances across the Southeast Bahamas by midweek, as it moves westward south of the island chain. By Thursday, a second frontal boundary moving across the southeastern US is forecast to reinforce the unsettled pattern across the northern islands, increasing rainfall chances and flood potential across the northern islands through Friday.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flooding: There is a **marginal** to **moderate** risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas, mainly across the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas**, especially during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 50 to 70% chance of scattered showers with thunderstorms late tonight into Tuesday.
WINDS: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots becoming gusty at times by evening hours on Tuesday.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 40 to 60% chance of scattered showers with thunderstorms late tonight through overnight hours. Expected to decrease to 20 to 40% late Tuesday morning.
WINDS: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly fair tonight becoming a bit hazy with a mix of sun and clouds on Tuesday.
PRECIPITATION: 10 to 30% chance of isolated showers.
WINDS: Light and variable tonight. Becoming Southerly at 10 to 15 knots on Tuesday.

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly fair tonight. Hazy skies on Tuesday.
PRECIPITATION: 10% chance of a stray shower or two.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MINIMUM:** **MAXIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: *Tropical cyclone formation is not expected through the next (7) seven days.*

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy
Northwest Bahamas: Partly to variably cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds
PRECIPITATION: **Northern Bahamas:** 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers.
Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southwest to west at 15 to 20 knots
Northwest Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots through the afternoon, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the evening hours.
Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, shifting east to southeast at less than 10 knots by the evening
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy
Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds
Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny to sunny
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers
Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing to 10 to 15 knots by the evening hours.
WINDS: **Northwest Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to less than 10 knots by the evening hours
Central Bahamas: East to Southeast at 10 to 15 knots
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Southeast Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds
Elsewhere: Partly cloudy to cloudy
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Central Southeast: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers
Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts during the evening hours
WINDS: **Northwest Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the evening hours
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 1ST AUGUST 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Variably cloudy

PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, falling to 10 knots or less by the evening hours across the Northern Bahamas.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeast at 15 to 20 knots or less
