



# BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, June 29, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.**

A moist unstable airmass remain across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas generating showers and thunderstorms across the above mentioned areas. Elsewhere, a tropical wave along with a westward moving trough is expected to enter the Southeast Bahamas early tomorrow morning generating unsettled weather in the area through tomorrow evening. Meanwhile high ridge continue across the country.

**GENERAL SITUATION:** **Outlook:** Wednesday the tropical wave and the surface trough will generate some early shower activity as the drift westward out of the area. At the same time, a moderate plume of Saharan Dust is anticipated to infiltrate the Southeast Bahamas which may act to suppress shower activity associated with the nearby wave. Persistent troughing across the Northern Islands will maintain showers and thunderstorms in the Northwestern part of the country through the end of the week.

**Rip Currents:** A *slight* to *moderate* risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed coastlines of the island chain. **Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.**

**SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:** **Heat/UV Index:** Members of the public are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as **UV indices** are expected to be in the *very high to extreme* range, and the **heat index** possibly reaching the *triple digits* across all areas.

 An area of disorganized showers and thunderstorm associated with low pressure along a frontal boundary has a low 10% chance of formation during the next 7 days.
