BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, March 9, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

| GENERAL SITUATION: | <p>The country remains under the influence of a high pressure ridge which is maintaining generally stable conditions, relatively warm temperatures, and gentle to fresh breezes.</p> <p>Meanwhile, a weak mid-level disturbance and low-level moisture continues to spark some shower and isolated thunderstorm activity, mainly across the Central Bahamas and portions of the southeastern islands into Tuesday. Elsewhere, strong daytime heating and ample low-level moisture may trigger a few odd showers and occasional afternoon thunderstorms.</p> <p>Outlook: For the remainder of the work week, expect generally stable and warmer than usual conditions, as deep ridging dominates. However, strong daytime heating will trigger occasional passing showers and afternoon thunderstorms. The surface ridge will gradually weaken towards Thursday, as a weak cold front moves into the Bahamas by early Friday morning, elevating shower and thunderstorm chances over the northern regions of the country. The frontal boundary is anticipated to stall over the Northwest Bahamas into Saturday.</p> |
| SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: | <p>Rip Currents: There remains a moderate to high risk of rip currents for the Atlantic waters and all east and southeast coastal waters of the island chain. <i>Swimmers in these areas are urged to remain nearshore.</i></p> <p>UV Index: Very high UV levels are expected over the next few days across portions of the island chain. Therefore, the public is urged to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing, such as wide-brimmed hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen, and to seek shaded areas during peak daylight hours.</p> |
