BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Monday, July 13, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

A Heat Advisory remains in effect for the entire Bahamas. Residents and visitors are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing, seek shaded areas and avoid prolonged sun exposure during peak sunshine hours (11am to 4pm).

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A Dust Advisory remains in effect for all islands of the Bahamas, as well as the Turks & Caicos Islands. Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.

Low-level troughing, combined with abundant tropical moisture, will continue to support showers and thunderstorms across the Northern and Northwestern Bahamas tonight. This activity is expected to move north of the area by Tuesday morning. Elsewhere, hot and humid conditions will persist through tomorrow, while a lingering plume of Saharan dust maintains hazy skies and reduced air quality. Gentle to moderate winds will prevail across the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas, with locally fresh winds continuing over the remaining islands.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Little change is expected over the next several days as high pressure and Saharan dust remain the dominant weather features across the archipelago. Light to moderate breezes will continue across the Northern, Northwestern, and Central Bahamas, while fresh easterly winds maintain breezy conditions over the Southeast Bahamas. Hot temperatures, hazy skies, and generally stable weather are expected to persist through the remainder of the week, with a few isolated passing showers possible.

Severe Weather Activity: There is a *marginal to moderate* risk for isolated strong to possibly severe thunderstorms late tonight into overnight hours in the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. *The public is advised to monitor for the issuance of any watches or warnings issued by The Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

Rip Currents: There is a *moderate* risk of rip currents for the east and southeastern Atlantic coasts of the Central Bahamas, and all area waters of the Southeast Bahamas including the southern territorial waters. *Swimmers are advised to exercise caution.*

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Tidal Levels: Due to the approaching *Super New Moon on Tuesday (14th July)*, there will be a *marginal risk* of tidal flooding along coastal and swamp areas, especially during the evening high tide hours starting tonight and continuing through to midweek.

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (11am – 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the *very high* range.

PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms possible during overnight hours.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less.

WINDS: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, with occasional gusts.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy
PRECIPITATION: All areas: 10 – 30% chance of showers.
Northern Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the evening hours.
WINDS: Northwest and Central Bahamas: East at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times in the Northwestern Islands.
Southeast Bahamas: East at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

Southeast Bahamas: East at 15 to 20 knots.

Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 91°F – 95°F / 33°C – 35°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 104°F – 110°F / 40°C – 43°C

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: All areas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots.
Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 91°F – 95°F / 33°C – 35°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 104°F – 110°F / 40°C – 43°C

PRECIPITATION: All areas: 10 - 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern & Northwest Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots.
Central & Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 104°F – 110°F / 40°C – 43°C

Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
