BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Saturday, July 5, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There are no public warnings in effect at this time.
GENERAL SITUATION:	The outer bands of Tropical Storm Chantal continue to promote bouts of unsettled weather and considerable cloudiness across the Northern & Northwest Bahamas as the system continues to trek generally northward. As a result, periods of showers and thunderstorms will remain possible tonight into tomorrow across the most Northern territories. Meanwhile, a relatively drier air mass and weak high pressure surface ridge supports more settled conditions across the Central & Southeastern Islands. Outlook: A gradual improvement in conditions can be expected in the Northern Islands through Sunday into Monday as Tropical Storm Chantal continues to pull away from our area. An incoming plume of Saharan dust will bring milky skies to portions of the Southeast & Central Bahamas while maintaining relatively dry and stable conditions across the areas into the start of the upcoming week. On Tuesday, an influx of Atlantic moisture will move across the archipelago followed by an additional moisture surge on Thursday from the Caribbean Sea. This will occur under the backdrop of a mid-level disturbance
	which will aid in the development of showers and thunderstorms across portions of this island chain through the work week.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	 Potential Tropical System Impacts: Tropical Storm Chantal will NOT directly impact the Bahamas. However, a few gusty winds and bouts of severe weather may be experienced across Grand Bahama and Abaco, along with periods of excessive rainfall and possible flooding. The public is urged to follow our forecasts, severe weather warnings and News Items on this system on our Facebook page or our website, met.gov.bs. Rip Currents: There is a moderate risk of rip currents in place for Atlantic-exposed coastal waters as well as the south coastal waters in the Northern Bahamas. Beachgoers are urged to exercise extreme caution in these areas.
