WARNING IN EFFECT:	A severe weather watch remains in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas through tonight. The public is asked to keep updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.	
	A stationary frontal boundary currently over the Northwest Bahamas along with a we area of low pressure, northeast of the area, will maintain showers and thunderstorms are those areas through the forecast period. Meanwhile, light to gentle winds associated we weak high pressure will continue to dominate the weather elsewhere.	
GENERAL SITUATION:	<i>Outlook:</i> The frontal boundary will lift northward and gradually weaken through the remainder of the weekend. However, instability associated with multi-layered troughing will remain across the northern half of the country meanwhile pockets of drier air will filter in tapering rainfall activity. Nevertheless, tropical moisture will remain sufficient to support isolated showers and thunderstorms heading into the new week. Light to gentle winds will persist through the early part of the week, increasing to moderate strength by midweek.	
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Flash Flood Risk: Flash flooding is possible in low lying and flood prone areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall events as well as areas already inundated with water. Heat/UV Index: Residents, particularly those in the Southeast Bahamas, are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing, such as wide-brimmed hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen, and to seek shaded areas during peak daylight hours due to heat indices reaching into the lower triple digits and UV levels in the high to extreme range.
