BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Saturday, March 7, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<p><i>There are no public warnings in effect at this time.</i></p> <p>A Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots) remains in effect for the Southeast Bahamas. For additional marine information, please view our Marine forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.</p> <p>The public is reminded to turn their clocks <i>forward by one hour before bed</i> tonight in anticipation of Daylight Savings time which begins Sunday 8th March, 2026 at 2am.</p>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A persistent high pressure systems remains across the Bahamas supporting moderate to fresh winds, moderate to rough seas and a few passing showers over most of the country. Meanwhile a mid-level trough is enhancing a low pressure area in the vicinity of the Windward Passage, producing scattered showers and possible thunderstorms over the Southeast islands.</p> <p>Outlook: Breezy to windy conditions with quick passing showers will continue across the Bahamas due to a strong surface ridge, while a wet weather pattern persists mainly across portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas into next week. A weak mid-level disturbance may develop over the region early in the work week, bringing an increased potential for severe weather and localized flooding across the southern half of the country. These precipitation chances will diminish by midweek, as high pressure and a drier air mass filters into the Bahamas once again.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Flash Flooding: There is a marginal risk of flooding, mainly in low-lying and flood-prone areas, across portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas into Sunday. <i>The public is urged to exercise caution in these areas, especially during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.</i></p> <p>Rip Currents and Rough Surf: There is a moderate to high risk of rip currents for all areas. <i>Beachgoers are strongly advised to refrain from entering the water in the Southeast Bahamas and Atlantic coastal waters and due to elevated seas and life-threatening surf conditions driven by moderate to strong winds.</i></p>
