



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Saturday, April 18, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.**

<b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>High pressure will dominate the weather across the Bahamas through tomorrow. Gentle to moderate winds and beautiful beaching, boating and fishing conditions will occur throughout the country. A quick passing afternoon showers are possible tomorrow.</p> <p><b>Outlook:</b> On Monday, a late season cold front will enter the Northern half of the country. A wet weather pattern will accompany this feature along with moderate to strong winds and rough seas, throughout the work week. Shower activity will decrease across the Northern Bahamas and portions of the Northwest Bahamas on Tuesday. Gusty winds, moderate to heavy rainfall, possible localized flooding in low lying/flood prone areas along with isolated strong thunderstorms may be possible along and ahead of the front.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b>UV Index:</b> <i>UV indices in the <b>very high to extreme</b> range are anticipated <b>between 10 am to 4pm tomorrow</b>.</i> The public is <b>urged to wear sunscreen, sun glasses, wide brimmed hats, protective clothing and limit prolonged sun exposure</b> while engaging in outdoor activities.</p> <p><b>Rip Currents:</b> A <b>marginal</b> risk of rip currents along all Atlantic-exposed beaches and shorelines. Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to exercise caution when entering these waters.</p>

SKY CONDITIONS:	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> Partly cloudy to cloudy. <b>Central Bahamas:</b> Variably cloudy <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> A mix of sun and clouds during the day, becoming variably cloudy overnight.		
PRECIPITATION:	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> 20-30% chance of showers, especially across Grand Bahama and North Abaco. <b>Northwest Bahamas:</b> 10 to 20% chance during the morning hours, increasing to a 20 to 30% chance by late morning /early afternoon <b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> 10 to 20% chance of showers		
WINDS:	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> Light and variable becoming north to northeast at 10 to 15 knots, increasing to 15 to 25 knots during the afternoon hours and 20 to 25 knots with <i>gusts to gale force</i> by Monday evening into overnight hours. <b>Northwest and Central Bahamas:</b> Easterly at 10 knots or less, <i>backing</i> Northeast to east at 15 to 25 knots by late morning/early afternoon hours. Winds in the <b>Northwest Bahamas</b> are expected to increase 20 to 25 knots with <i>possible gusts to gale force during the night into overnight hours.</i> <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots increasing 15 to 20 knots overnight.

PRECIPITATION:	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> 20 to 40% chance of showers during the morning hours, decreasing to 10 to 20% chance by the afternoon hours. <b>Northwest and Central Bahamas:</b> 30 to 50% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> 20 to 30% chance of showers.

PRECIPITATION:	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> 10 to 20% chance of passing showers. <b>Central Bahamas:</b> 10 to 30% chance of showers <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> 30 to 40% chance of showers.

<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Southeastern Bahamas:</b> East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots falling light and variable at times. <b>Elsewhere:</b> Easterly at 15 to 20 knots with occasional gusts.

<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> 10 to 20 % chance of isolated showers <b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> 40 to 60% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:</b> Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, becoming east to northeast at 10 knots or less by evening. <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable in the afternoon.
