BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Saturday, July 25, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

*A **Dust Advisory** is in effect for the Southeast Bahamas as well as the Turks and Caicos Islands.* Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.

A surge of tropical moisture interacting with multi-layer troughing will continue to produce showers and thunderstorms across the Northern, Northwest and parts of the Central Bahamas tonight. Some showers are expected to be moderate to heavy, while thunderstorms may become strong too severe at times, creating the potential for hazardous weather. On Sunday, an approaching cold front, combined with an already unstable atmosphere will further enhance the chance of unsettled weather. Meanwhile, a plume of Saharan dust will spread across the Southeast Bahamas and the Turks and Caicos Islands, resulting in hazy skies, reduced air quality, and fewer showers and thunderstorms in those areas.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: As this system lingers near the islands through the middle of next week, repeated rounds of heavy showers and thunderstorms could lead to localized flooding in low lying, urban and already inundated areas, especially across the northern islands. Meanwhile, high pressure ridging and SAL will keep Southeast and portions of the Central Bahamas mostly warm, dry, and hazy through early next week, with another plume of Saharan dust limiting shower activity. By late Tuesday, a strong tropical wave is expected to move into the Southern Bahamas, increasing the chance of showers and thunderstorms across the Central and Southeast Bahamas through Thursday.

Severe Weather Risk: There is a **moderate** to **high** risk for isolated strong to severe thunderstorms, particularly across the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas** tonight and Sunday. The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flooding: There is a **marginal** to **moderate** risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas, mainly across the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas**, especially during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.

Rip Currents: There is a **moderate** to **high** risk of rip currents for Atlantic-exposed waters and southeast coastal waters of the archipelago. *Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to avoid entering waters of the Southeast Bahamas. Swimmers ought not to venture into waters where they cannot comfortably stand.*

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly cloudy to cloudy.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 to 30% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms tonight increasing to 40 to 50% chance of showers tomorrow.		
WINDS:	Southeast tonight shifting south to southwest at 10 knots or less tomorrow.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms through tomorrow
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less tonight shifting south to southwest at 10 knots or less tomorrow.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots tonight becoming light and variable at less than 10 knots tomorrow
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy and hazy through tomorrow
PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots tonight increasing to 15 to 20 knots tomorrow
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 92°F / 32°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 100°F – 105°F / 38°C – 41°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: Tropical cyclone activity is not expected during the next seven (7) days.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 27TH JULY 2026

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Cloudy to overcast, becoming variably cloudy at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny and hazy, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 50 to 70% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, shifting southwest to west at 10 knots, falling light and variable at times by the afternoon.
Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the evening.
Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts during the morning hours, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing to 15 knots by nightfall.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 100°F / 36°C – 38°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY 28TH JULY 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern Bahamas: Cloudy to overcast.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.
Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 40 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers.
Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 81°F – 88°F / 27°C – 31°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 79°F / 23°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 100°F / 36°C – 38°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 29TH JULY 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Northern Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

PRECIPITATION: Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots by the evening hours.

WINDS: Northwest and Central Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots by nightfall.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

Northern Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

PRECIPITATION: Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 15 to 20 knots.

WINDS: Northwest and Central Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
82°F – 90°F / 28°C – 32°C 77°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

SKY CONDITIONS: Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds
Elsewhere: Partly cloudy to cloudy

PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 10 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 to 20 knots by the evening hours

WINDS: Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less
Central Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots through the morning hours, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours.
Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Variably cloudy

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots occasionally 15 to 20 knots.

WINDS: Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeast at 15 to 20 knots or less, falling to less than 10 knots.
