BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Saturday, September 26, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time.

An early season cold front has slowed down and will begin to weaken in the vicinity of the Central and Southeast Bahamas tonight. Showers and thunderstorms associated with this system will continue across the areas through tomorrow. Behind the front in the northern islands a dryer more stable airmass has moved in, allowing limited shower activity through tomorrow. Moderate sea swells are occurring in the Northern and Northwest Islands and along all Atlantic Exposures due to a deep low pressure area north of the country.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: High pressure will build across the region on Monday, lifting the front northward as winds strengthen. By Tuesday, a shortwave trough interacting with moisture from a Caribbean tropical wave will bring a more unsettled weather pattern across the country through much of the work week. The swath of showers and thunderstorms will shift northwards, as the surface ridge continues to strengthen, bringing improved conditions across all areas by Friday. Swells will begin to subside along Atlantic shorelines beginning tomorrow, returning to nominal levels by Monday.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: There is a *slight* to *moderate* risk for a few strong isolated to severe thunderstorms across **portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas**. These storms could produce strong gusty winds, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and waterspout activity. *Residents and visitors remain vigilant and stay updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

Rip Currents: There is a *moderate* to *high* risk of hazardous rip currents and rough surf across **all Atlantic waters**. *Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly urged to refrain from entering Gulf Stream and Atlantic-exposed waters and should continue to exercise caution elsewhere.*
