BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Sunday, February 1, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<p>A Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots) is NOW in effect for the Northern & Northwest Bahamas until midnight and for the Central & Southeast Bahamas through 6am on Monday. Near gale force wind gusts are possible across these areas through the duration of the warnings.</p> <p>Please see the Marine Forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.</p>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>The region remains under the influence of a cold, dry Arctic air mass, along with a strong pressure gradient created by building high pressure to the west and a deep, complex low pressure system well to the northeast. These features will sustain a wintry feel across the island chain tonight through tomorrow, with fresh to strong breezes and hazardous marine conditions persisting into the upcoming week.</p> <p>Outlook: Temperatures are expected to gradually rebound to near seasonal norms by midweek as the northerly flow weakens and an easterly wind flow develops with high pressure migrating across the area. Stable and mostly dry conditions should prevail through the first half of the work week, while seas are forecast to slowly subside by midweek ahead of another front expected to approach the Northern Bahamas toward the end of the work week.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Temperatures: Temperatures in the mid to upper 40s across the Northern Bahamas and mid to upper 50s in the Northwest Bahamas are forecast for tonight.</p> <p><i>Daytime high temperatures are only expected to reach the mid to upper 50s in the Northern Bahamas on Monday. Therefore, residents are encouraged to take precautions for themselves, pets, the elderly, and small children. Dress in warm, layered clothing and ensure children are properly protected from the cool temperatures.</i></p> <p>Rip Currents: There is a high risk of dangerous, life threatening rip currents and rough surf along all windward and Atlantic shorelines. The public is urged to remain out of the water until further notice.</p> <p>Coastal Threats: Overtopping waves and sea spray may cause coastal flooding along northern and western roadways today. Motorists and pedestrians should avoid these areas especially during high tide cycle.</p>
