BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Sunday, October 12, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<i>A severe weather watch is in effect for the island of Eleuthera and the islands of the Central Bahamas tonight.</i> <i>The public is urged to keep updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.</i>
GENERAL SITUATION:	A stationary front located over the Northwestern Bahamas will continue to support showers and thunderstorms across the Central Bahamas and portions of the Northwest and Southeast Bahamas through tomorrow. Meanwhile, over the Northern Bahamas, a drier and relatively cooler air mass will lead to more stable conditions. Outlook: The frontal boundary is expected to remain over the Northwest Bahamas and continue to support showers and thunderstorms over portions of the Northwest and Central Bahamas until early next week. By the middle to end of next week, a reinforcing frontal boundary is expected to move across the area, resulting in drier, cooler and more stable conditions over the entire island chain.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Flood Risk: For portions of the Northwest Bahamas and Central Bahamas, flooding is likely in urban, low-lying, and flood-prone areas during heavy and prolonged rainfall events into the beginning of the work week. The public is advised to exercise caution when traversing these areas. Rip Currents: There remains a moderate to high risk of rip currents along Atlantic exposed shorelines across the island chain, especially in the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. Beachgoers, swimmers, and pleasure craft operators in the Northern and Northwest Bahamas are urged not to venture into the water along Atlantic exposures, while elsewhere, beachgoers and swimmers are asked to exercise caution. Coastal threats: There remains the risk of minor coastal erosion and flooding along the shorelines of the Bahamas during high tide tonight through to early next week, due to astronomically higher tides during the current Full Moon cycle. Expect tides to return to nominal levels by Tuesday of next week.
