## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Sunday, February 15, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

<b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b>	<p><i>There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time. A <b>Near Gale (28–33 knots)</b> Warning is now in effect for the Northern Bahamas. Occasional gusts to near-gale force are likely across and to the north these areas tonight and until 12 pm Monday. Boaters, especially small craft operators, are urged to seek safe shelter and remain in port. For additional marine information, please see our Marine forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.</i></p>
<b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>A ridge of high pressure across the area will continue to provide tranquil weather around the islands as it shifts eastwards into the western Atlantic. <b>Outlook:</b> The cold front, accompanied by scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms, is expected to enter the Northern islands on Monday. The front will quickly move through the island chain and reach the Southeastern islands by Tuesday. High pressure will build across the archipelago by mid-week, contributing once again to more stable weather conditions.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b>Rip Currents:</b> There remains a moderate to high risk of hazardous rip currents and rough surf along all Atlantic exposed shorelines of the island chain. Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to avoid entering the water in these areas.</p>

<b>WINDS:</b>	South to Southwest at 15 to 20 knots becoming Southwest to West at 15 to 25 knots tomorrow as the front moves into the area.
