BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Sunday, January 25, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<i>A Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots) will come into effect for the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas Monday 4pm through noon on Wednesday. Occasional gusts to gale force are possible across the mentioned areas. Boaters, especially small craft, are urged to remain in port by noon Monday. GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A high pressure ridge will support fresh breezes and warmer temperatures across the island chain while slowly shifting northeast through Monday afternoon. Meanwhile, pulses of low-level moisture will aid in the development of some isolated shower activity mainly across portions of the Central Bahamas through tonight.</p> <p><b>Outlook:</b> Pre-frontal activity ahead of a strong cold front, is expected to generate scattered showers over the Northern islands on Monday. The frontal boundary is expected to arrive by the afternoon along with moderate to strong winds with gusts to near gale force beginning in the Northern islands by tomorrow night and spreading into the Northwest and Central islands Tuesday and Wednesday. This system will generate another round of cooler temperatures through midweek before stalling just north of the Southeast Bahamas. A reinforcing front will quickly follow by early Thursday morning, eventually merging with the previous front and will exit the country that evening. This will allow temperatures to dip towards more comfortable values across all areas by the end of the work week.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<b>Rip Currents:</b> There is a <b>moderate to high</b> risk of rip currents on the Atlantic waters of the island chain, as well as the open waters of the Central and Southeast Bahamas. Beachgoers are advised to exercise caution when entering these waters.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Fair tonight, becoming partly cloudy tomorrow.		
PRECIPITATION:	10% chance of a stray shower through tonight, increasing to a 30% chance of scattered showers tomorrow.		
WINDS:	South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots shifting southwest to west tomorrow ahead of the front.

PRECIPITATION:	10% chance of an isolated shower or two tonight increasing to 20% tomorrow		
WINDS:	southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots occasionally falling to 10 knots or less

WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing 10 knots or less tomorrow.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Mostly fair tonight, becoming partly sunny tomorrow		
PRECIPITATION:	10 to20% chance of an isolated shower or two.		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots decreasing to 10 to 15 knots tomorrow.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY 27 <sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2026:			
SKY CONDITIONS:	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> Partly cloudy to cloudy. <b>Central Bahamas:</b> Mostly sunny at first, becoming increasingly cloudy as the front moves into the area by the afternoon hours. Expect cloudy conditions by nightfall. <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> Partly sunny to sunny during the day, turning mostly fair by nightfall.		
PRECIPITATION:	<b>Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:</b> 20 – 40% chance of showers in the vicinity of the front <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> 10 – 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	<b>Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:</b> Variable at 10 knots or less ahead of the front, shifting north to northeast at 15 to 25 knots with <b><u>occasional gusts to near gale.</u></b> <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> Variable at 10 knots or less, becoming north to northeast at 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.

SKY CONDITIONS:	<b>Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:</b> Cloudy to occasionally overcast. <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	<b>Central Bahamas:</b> 20 – 30% chance of showers. <b>Northern, Northwest and Southeast Bahamas:</b> 10 – 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 15 knots with occasionally higher gusts, decreasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall. <b>Central Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 15 to 25 knots, decreasing 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts by nightfall. <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times at night.

SKY CONDITIONS:	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> Mostly cloudy during the day, turning mostly fair at night. <b>Northwest and Central Bahamas:</b> Cloudy to occasionally overcast. <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> A mix of sun and clouds during the day, turning mostly cloudy at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> 10% chance of showers. <b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> 20 – 30% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	<b>Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:</b> Northwest to north at 15 to 25 knots after the frontal passage. <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> West to northwest at 15 knots, veering north to northeast at 15 to 25 knots after the passage of the front by nightfall.

PRECIPITATION:	All areas: 10% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: North-northwest to north-northeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times. Central and Southeast Bahamas: North to northeast at 15 to 20 knots, veering northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts by the afternoon hours.

SKY CONDITIONS:	All areas: A mix of sun and clouds during the day, turning partly cloudy to cloudy at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	All areas: 10% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: West to northwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times, veering northwest to north at 20 to 25 knots with higher gusts after the frontal passage. Central Bahamas: North-northwest to north-northeast at 10 to 15 knots, veering northwesterly at 15 to 20 knots by the early evening. Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times ahead of the front, becoming northerly at 15 to 20 knots by nightfall behind the front.
