BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Sunday, September 27, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time.

Trouching associated with the remnants of a frontal boundary will continue to support cloudy skies and elevated showers and isolated thunderstorm activity across portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas this evening, with the troughing expected to weaken overnight. By Monday, residual moisture will shift northward across the island chain, increasing shower chances across the Northwest Bahamas as ridging begins to rebuild across the island chain. Moderate swells will continue across the Northern and Northwest Islands and Atlantic exposures due to a deep low-pressure area north of the country.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The remnants of the front will continue to lift northward and interact with a developing low-pressure area near South Florida. Along with an incoming shortwave trough, these features will result in a return to more unsettled weather across the Bahamas through much of the work week. As the surface ridge strengthens by mid-week, fresh to strong breezes are expected across the Bahamas through Friday.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: There is a *slight* to *moderate* risk for a few strong isolated to severe thunderstorms across **portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas**. These storms could produce strong gusty winds, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and waterspout activity. *Residents and visitors remain vigilant and stay updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

Rip Currents: There is a *moderate* to *high* risk of hazardous rip currents and rough surf across **all Atlantic waters**. *Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly urged to refrain from entering Gulf Stream and Atlantic-exposed waters and should continue to exercise caution elsewhere.*
