BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Sunday, August 30, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has issued a Special Weather Statement regarding the remnants of Dolly and the potential for inclement weather conditions across The Bahamas during the upcoming week. For the full statement and latest information, please visit our website: met.gov.bs

WARNING IN EFFECT:

*A **Severe Weather Watch** remains in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas tonight. The public should monitor for the issuance of any warnings or updates from The Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

*A **Near Gale Warning** is now in effect for the Southeast Bahamas.*

GENERAL SITUATION:

Pooling tropical moisture and slight troughing just south of a frontal boundary across the southeastern US will continue to support scattered showers and thunderstorms across the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas through Monday. Elsewhere, high pressure will dominate briefly during the overnight hours, as a robust tropical wave (remnants of Dolly) approaches the Southeast Bahamas. Gusty winds and occasionally heavy showers and thunderstorms will accompany this system, as it progresses westwards throughout the day on Monday.

Outlook: Beginning late Tuesday, the presence of a westward moving tropical wave and its associated moisture will produce an increased risk of flooding and severe weather conditions, as a wet and unsettled weather pattern continues across the archipelagic chain (*See Special Weather Statement*). By the end of the work week, drier conditions will return as high pressure ridging builds across the country. On Sunday, A cold front will move off the eastern US coastline, introducing pre-frontal conditions across the northern territories.

Flood Risk: There is a **slight** to **moderate** risk for flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall periods, especially over portions of the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas**.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: A **high risk** of rip currents exists along **eastern and southern shorelines of the Southeast Bahamas**, while a **slight** to **moderate** risk persists elsewhere. **Beachgoers and swimmers in the Southeast Bahamas are strongly advised to refrain from entering the water, while those elsewhere should exercise caution when entering the water.**

PRECIPITATION:	10 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms tonight, increasing 30 – 50% on Monday.		
WINDS:	Northeast to east at 15 knots tonight, increasing 15 to 20 knots with gusts to near gale on Monday.

TROPICAL
WEATHER
OUTLOOK:

There are currently two areas of interest that are being monitored for development:

1) **Near Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands (Remnants of Dolly):** A strong tropical wave, the remnants of Dolly, currently moving westwards across Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands has a **low, or 20 percent chance of tropical cyclone formation through the next seven days. Regardless of development, the system will contribute to heavy showers and thunderstorms across the Bahamas beginning mid-week. The Bahamas Department of Meteorology will continue to monitor this tropical wave and will issue updates as needed.**

2) **Northern Gulf of Mexico (AL97):** A low pressure area located over the northern Gulf of Mexico has a **medium, or 50 percent chance of tropical cyclone formation during the next 48 hours and through seven days.** A short-lived tropical depression or tropical storm could form before the system reaches the Upper Texas or southwestern Louisiana coasts by Tuesday night.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, becoming gusty at times in the Southeast Bahamas.
