BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Sunday, March 29, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A cold front draped across the Northwest Bahamas will introduce cloudy conditions along with a few showers as the system slowly drift southeastwards through the island chain tonight. A tightening pressure gradient between the front and building high pressure behind it will support fresh to strong breezes across the archipelago.</p> <p><i>Outlook:</i> Fresh to strong breezes, with occasional gusts approaching near gale force and rough seas, especially along Atlantic coastlines, will persist through much of the upcoming week. The cold front is expected to sweep through the island chain, exiting the Southeast Bahamas by early Tuesday, after which high pressure will become the dominant weather feature. Meanwhile, Atlantic moisture, driven by the brisk wind flow, will support occasional showers across the archipelago throughout the work week.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p><i>Coastal Flooding and Over-Topping Waves:</i> There is a moderate to high risk of overtopping waves along seawalls and coastal roads along Atlantic-exposed shorelines, especially the Glass Window Bridge on the island of Eleuthera beginning today. A marginal risk of coastal flooding is expected across all other northern and eastern-facing coastal roadways. <i>Motorists and residents are urged to exercise extreme caution while traversing these areas.</i></p> <p><i>Rip Currents:</i> Rough surf conditions and dangerous rip currents will plague the area waters of the island chain beginning today. These conditions are expected to continue until mid-week. <i>Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to avoid entering the waters.</i></p>

WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 25 knots gusts to near gale force likely. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with gusts up to near gale force.
