BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Thursday, July 3, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

IN EFFECT:	all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.
GENERAL SITUATION:	Trapped, abundant tropical moisture and troughing ahead of an old frontal boundary draped across the southeastern U.S. will promote cloudiness across much of the island chain while triggering heavier showers and thunderstorms across portions of the Northern Bahamas. Broad ridging will sustain relatively stable conditions in a moderate to fresh wind regime throughout the period. A low pressure system is forecast to develop north of the Bahamas on Friday, keeping a wet weather pattern across the northernmost islands.
	<i>Outlook:</i> Rain bands from this system will impact portions of the island chain this weekend. The low will lift northwards, gradually decreasing shower and thunderstorm chances through early next week, as high pressure builds westwards across the area.
	Potential Tropical System Impacts: A low is forecast to develop off the coast of Florida on Friday, and may become a tropical or sub-tropical system later on this weekend. Although this system will not
	directly impact the Bahamas, strong to gale force winds may potentially be experienced across
SPECIAL	Grand Bahama, Bimini and Abaco, with periods of excessive rainfall and bouts of severe weather
WEATHER	occurring over portions of the island chain beginning on Friday and continuing for this weekend.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: Near the Southeastern U.S.: An area of low pressure is forecast to develop along a weakening frontal boundary near Florida or the Atlantic coast of the southeastern United States on Friday or Saturday. This system has a low, or 30 percent chance of tropical cyclone formation through the next 48 hours, increasing to a medium, or 60 percent chance of development into either a sub-tropical or tropical system over the next seven days as the low drifts northward or northeastwards.
