BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Thursday, September 3, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING EFFECT: IN No public warnings are in effect at this time.

An unsettled weather pattern will persist across the northern half of the country through Friday, resulting in periods of cloudiness, widely scattered showers, and isolated thunderstorms. These conditions are being driven by surface troughing over the northern islands, enhanced by a broad mid-level disturbance and abundant tropical moisture. Elsewhere, generally stable conditions will prevail as ridging and drier air dominate. However, occasional showers and isolated afternoon thunderstorms may still develop, particularly during peak daytime heating.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Weak troughing and lingering tropical moisture across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas will continue to support cloudy spells along with occasional afternoon showers and thunderstorms through most of the weekend. On Sunday, troughing associated with a frontal boundary near the southeastern United States is expected to bring another increase in shower and thunderstorm activity across the Northern Bahamas. Meanwhile, an approaching tropical wave is expected to enter the Southeast Bahamas, resulting in an uptick in showers and thunderstorm chances across that region.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: There is a slight to moderate risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of the Northern & Northwest Bahamas tonight through tomorrow. These storms are capable of producing strong gusty winds, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and waterspout activity. Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flood Risk: There is a slight to moderate risk for flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall periods, especially over portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas.

Rip Currents: There is a slight to moderate risk of rip currents along the eastern and southern shorelines of the Bahamas. Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to exercise caution along eastern and southern shorelines.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly fair tonight, with a mix of sun and clouds expected tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 10 – 30% chance of isolated showers with a slight chance of an isolated thunderstorm or two.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

SKY CONDITIONS: Mainly fair tonight, becoming partly to mostly sunny tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 10 – 20% chance of a few isolated showers.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts at times.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

As we approach the peak of the Atlantic hurricane season, the tropical Atlantic remains relatively quiet at this time. However, conditions can change and residents across The Bahamas are reminded to remain prepared and continue monitoring official weather information throughout the remainder of the hurricane season.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 5TH SEPTEMBER, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 30 to 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less by the afternoon to evening hours
TEMPERATURES: MAXIMUM: MINIMUM: HEAT INDEX:

Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds,
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 30 to 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable by the evening hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less by the afternoon.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less across the Central Bahamas by the afternoon

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 knots.
