BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Thursday, August 21, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<i>A Heat Advisory will be in effect for The Bahamas on Friday. Expect feel-like temperatures to reach upwards to 112°F. The public is urged to remain hydrated, seek shaded areas and avoid rigorous physical activity between 10am – 5pm.</i>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>Spontaneous shower and thunderstorm activity due to trailing moisture in the wake of Erin will taper off heading into the overnight hours, and will return by Friday afternoon, as the storm continues to drift further away from the area. Despite Erin’s distance from the Bahamas, hazardous beaching conditions will remain in place for the northern and eastern Atlantic shorelines. Weak ridging will support light winds and extremely warm temperatures heading into the weekend.</p> <p><i>Outlook:</i> Showers will remain in the forecast through the start of the weekend as high pressure reestablishes itself across the area, restoring the typical summertime pattern. Expect very hot and humid conditions with the occasional passing shower or isolated afternoon thunderstorm.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p><i>Rip currents:</i> There is a moderate risk of hazardous rip currents and locally rough surf affecting all Atlantic exposures. Residents and beachgoers along Atlantic exposed coastlines, are still urged to refrain from venturing in or near the ocean.</p> <p><i>Coastal Threats:</i> There remains a slight risk of minor coastal flooding and coastal erosion for all Atlantic shorelines, especially during periods of high tide.</p> <p><i>UV Index:</i> For Friday and heading into the weekend, the public is urged to wear protective clothing and seek shaded areas during peak daylight hours, due to anticipated high to extreme UV indices.</p>

SKY CONDITIONS:	Mostly fair, with occasional cloudy patches mainly across Grand Bahamas and Bimini tonight. A mix of sun and clouds on Friday.		
PRECIPITATION:	10 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

PRECIPITATION:	10 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Variable at 10 knots or less tonight. South-southwest to west-southwest at 10 knots or less on Friday.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Mostly fair tonight, turning mostly sunny on Friday.		
PRECIPITATION:	10 – 20% chance of showers. Expect possible thunderstorms during the afternoon hours on Friday.		
WINDS:	South-southwest to west-southwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times tonight, shifting south-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less on Friday.

PRECIPITATION:	10 – 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:	Please see the latest news item on Hurricane Erin. Elsewhere, there are three (3) other areas of interest.		
	1. Near the Leeward Islands in the Tropical Atlantic (AL90): A tropical wave located a few hundred miles east of the Leeward Islands has a medium, or 50 percent chance of tropical cyclone formation through the next 48 hours, and a high, or 70% chance of development over the next seven days. A tropical depression is likely to form this weekend as the system moves near or to the north of the northern Leeward Islands.		
	2. Eastern Tropical Atlantic (AL99): Another tropical wave located several hundred miles west-southwest of the Cabo Verde Islands has a medium, or 40 percent chance of tropical cyclone formation within 48 hours and through the next seven (7) days.		
	3. Central Atlantic: A small area of low pressure located about 1200 miles southwest of the Azores has a low, or 30 percent chance of tropical cyclone formation within 48 hours and through the next seven (7) days.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Variably cloudy across the Northern/Northwest & Central Bahamas. Partly sunny elsewhere.		
PRECIPITATION:	10% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms over the Southeast Bahamas. 20-30% chance of widely scattered showers and thunderstorms elsewhere.		
WINDS:	Northern & Northwest Bahamas: Light and variable. Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less. Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

WINDS:	Northern & Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less falling light and variable at times. Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots falling light and variable at times. Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots.
