BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Thursday, February 12, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

GENERAL SITUATION:	Overnight, a weak frontal boundary will slip into the Northern Bahamas, bringing a few showers through early Friday, before slowly creeping into the Northwest Bahamas by the afternoon. Meanwhile, weak troughing supporting some cloudy conditions and isolated showers in the Southeast Bahamas will gradually weaken as the boundary drifts southward. Winds are expected to remain light to moderate through Friday evening. Outlook: The front is expected to gradually weaken as residual moisture persists across the island chain into the weekend. In its wake, high pressure will build through the latter half of the weekend, ushering in warmer temperatures and occasionally brisk breezes. By Sunday, a developing low-pressure system off the U.S. East Coast will drive another frontal boundary toward the area. This system may introduce a more active weather pattern, primarily across the northern territories, by Monday, before high pressure returns and more stable conditions reestablish by midweek.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Rip Currents: There is a moderate risk of rip currents for all coastal Atlantic waters of the island chain. Beachgoers and swimmers are asked to exercise caution in these areas.

WINDS:	Northwest to north at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, becoming north to northeast at 10 knots or less.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Fair tonight, becoming a mix of sun and clouds tomorrow		
PRECIPITATION:	Less than 10% chance of an isolated shower tonight, increasing to 20 to 40% chance tomorrow afternoon.		
WINDS:	Northwest at 10 knots or less, becoming northerly at less than 10 knots.		
TEMPERATURES:	MAXIMUM: 77°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C	MINIMUM: 55°F – 61°F / 13°C – 16°C	WIND CHILL: N/A

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR Monday 16th February 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy, with gradual clearing through the period. Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 15 to 25 knots with higher gusts, veering southwest to west at 15 knots by nightfall. Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, veering southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.

PRECIPITATION:	All areas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: West to northwest at 10 to 15 knots ahead of the front, veering north to northeast at 15 knots in the wake of the frontal passage. Southeast Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times, veering west to northwest at 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.
