



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Thursday, August 6, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT: *No public warnings in effect.*

A deep-layered trough moving westward through the island chain, combined with abundant streaming tropical moisture, will continue to support showers and thunderstorms as the primary weather feature across the country through tomorrow. Meanwhile, a strengthening pressure gradient will maintain moderate to fresh winds and moderate to occasionally rough seas, especially across Atlantic-exposed waters around the island chain.

GENERAL SITUATION: **Outlook:** Heading into the weekend and continuing through the middle of next week, a strengthening ridge of high pressure will bring a more stable air mass across The Bahamas, resulting in a gradual decrease in shower and thunderstorm activity. However, lingering moisture over the northern half of the country may still support a few isolated showers and thunderstorms at times. Marine conditions, including across Atlantic waters, will also improve as seas subside to slight to moderate. Winds will remain mostly moderate, becoming occasionally fresh across portions of the Southeast Bahamas.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: *There is a moderate to high risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across the Bahamas.* These storms are capable of producing *strong gusty winds*, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and *waterspout activity*. *Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: **Rip Currents:** There is a moderate risk of rip currents for the Atlantic coastal waters of the Bahamas archipelago and east and southeast sheltered coastal waters of parts of the Central and the entire Southeast Bahamas.

UV Index: Members of the public are still advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (11am – 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the very high to extreme range.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy tonight becoming cloudy tomorrow.

PRECIPITATION: 40 to 50% chance of intermittent showers and isolated thunderstorms decreasing to 30% by late Friday afternoon

WINDS: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, becoming east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots tomorrow afternoon.

TEMPERATURES:

MAXIMUM: 86°F – 90°F / 30°C – 32°C

MINIMUM: 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C

HEAT INDEX: 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy tonight becoming cloudy tomorrow

PRECIPITATION: 40 to 50% chance of intermittent showers and isolated thunderstorms decreasing to 30% by late Friday afternoon.

WINDS: East to southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots.

TEMPERATURES:

MAXIMUM: 86°F – 90°F / 30°C – 32°C

MINIMUM: 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C

HEAT INDEX: 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C



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CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 30% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 30% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: *Tropical cyclone activity is not expected during the next 7 days.*

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 8TH AUGUST, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: A mix of sun and clouds
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts across the Northwest Bahamas.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 9TH AUGUST, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers.
Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 10TH AUGUST, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: A mix of sun and clouds
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20-30% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or a thunderstorm
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.
WINDS: Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY 11TH AUGUST, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: A mix of sun and clouds.
PRECIPITATION: All Areas: 10 to 30% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: Northern & Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.
Central & Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C



EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 12TH AUGUST, 2026

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy
Elsewhere: A mix of sun and clouds

PRECIPITATION: All areas: 10 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms

WINDS: Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the afternoon hours
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots

TEMPERATURES: MAXIMUM: MINIMUM: HEAT INDEX:
84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: A mix of sun and clouds, fair at night.

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Light and variably at 10 knots or less.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots
