BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Thursday, February 5, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<p>A Gale Warning (34 – 40 knots) and Wind Advisory is now in effect for the <u>Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas</u>. A Near Gale Near Warning (28 – 33 knots) is in effect for the <u>Southeast Bahamas</u>.</p> <p><i>Small craft operators in these areas are urged to seek safe harbour and remain in port. For additional marine information, please view our marine forecast at met.gov.bs.</i></p> <p><i>A Severe Weather Watch is in effect for the <u>entire Southeast Bahamas and the Turks and Caicos Islands</u>, <u>until midnight</u>. The general public is advised to remain up to date on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.</i></p>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p><i>A strong cold front will swiftly move across the country tonight, merging with a surface trough across the Southeast Bahamas tomorrow morning. Widely scattered showers are ahead of the front with strong to gale force winds and rough seas following behind. Scattered showers and widely scattered thunderstorms will continue across the Southeast Bahamas due to the trough in the above mentioned islands.</i></p> <p>Outlook: Strong winds will persist on Friday, with a lighter wind regime coming into effect across portions of the Bahamas as the low pulls into the northern Atlantic. A secondary low will form northeast of the area, keeping choppy and high seas in place along Atlantic beaches. A dry continental airmass will linger across the region in the wake of the cold front, keeping lower than usual temperatures and negligible rain chances in place throughout the archipelago this weekend heading into next week. High pressure will gradually build towards the end of the extended forecast period, ushering in a welcomed warming trend by midweek next week.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Rip Currents and Rough Surf: There is a high risk of dangerous, life-threatening rip currents and rough surf along all exposed shorelines of the island chain. Beachgoers and swimmers should avoid entering the water in these regions.</p> <p>Coastal Threats: There is a minor to moderate threat of beach erosion and coastal flooding for all shorelines, especially in areas that have already been severely impacted this past weekend. Motorists and pedestrians are urged to continue to exercise caution while traversing these areas due to the possibility of overtopping waves, sea spray and coastal debris, especially during high tide.</p>
