BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Thursday, September 18, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There remains a marginal risk for a few isolated strong to possibly severe thunderstorms particularly across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas tonight and tomorrow. These storms have the potential to produce strong gusty winds, heavy downpours, frequent lightning, and possible waterspout and/or tornadic activity.
GENERAL SITUATION:	Tropical moisture along with a deepening surface trough across the Northern Bahamas continues to produce unsettled weather across the Northern and Northwest Islands. Meanwhile high pressure is supporting gentle to moderate winds across the country. Outlook: The trough will linger across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas through the weekend. With the influx of tropical moisture the Northern and Northwest Bahamas will remain wet and soggy.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<i>Flooding:</i> There is an elevated risk of ponding of water on roadways and localized flooding in low lying or flood prone areas during heavy downpours showers or prolonged rainfall events.
