BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Thursday, July 23, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

A deep layered trough across the Central Bahamas is drifting westward across the Northwest and Central Bahamas tonight and will cross the Northern Islands tomorrow. The trough is being followed by an upper level disturbance and both systems are actively generating showers and thunderstorms throughout the archipelago. Gentle to fresh breezes and slight to moderate seas will continue through tomorrow.

GENERAL SITUATION: **Outlook:** An approaching tropical wave, will continue to drift westward entering the island chain this weekend. Meanwhile, a frontal boundary is forecast to stall near the southeastern US, keeping moisture and unsettled conditions lingering across the Northern Bahamas into early next week. As high pressure gradually rebuilds across the region, improving weather conditions are expected to spread across the Central and Southeast Bahamas throughout the weekend and into early next week. By Tuesday, another robust tropical wave is forecast to enter the area, ushering in a renewed threat of showers and thunderstorms across the southern half of the country by midweek.

Severe Weather Risk: There is a moderate risk for isolated strong to severe thunderstorms particularly across portions of the Northwest Bahamas and Central Bahamas this evening and overnight and the Northern and Northwest Bahamas on Friday. The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: **Heat/UV Index:** Members of the public are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (11am – 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the very high to extreme range, and the heat index possibly reaching the triple digits across all areas.

Rip Currents: There is a moderate to high risk of rip currents for Atlantic-exposed waters and southeast coastal waters of the archipelago. Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to avoid entering waters of the Southeast Bahamas. Swimmers ought not to venture into waters where they cannot comfortably stand. Rough surf conditions will affect the waters of the island chain until the weekend.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Fair to partly cloudy tonight, becoming cloudy tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms tonight, increasing 30 to 60% tomorrow.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots tonight, becoming southeast at 10 knots or less tomorrow.

PRECIPITATION: 30 to 60% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots tonight, becoming southeasterly tomorrow.

SKY CONDITIONS: Cloudy tonight, becoming variably cloudy tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 60% chance of scattered showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots tonight, decreasing 10 to 15 knots tomorrow.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 82°F – 88°F / 28°C – 31°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 79°F / 23°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy tonight, becoming variably cloudy tomorrow.
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 50% chance of widely scattered showers tonight becoming 20 to 30% chance tomorrow.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, becoming
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 79°F / 23°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny with a few cloudy periods.
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers
Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours.
WINDS: Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Elsewhere: A mix of sun and clouds.
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers
WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Light and variable at 10 knots or less
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 100°F / 36°C – 38°C

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Cloudy to occasionally overcast.
Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, partly cloudy at night.
Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny, turning mostly fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: Southwest at less than 10 knots
Northwest and Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots
Southeast Bahamas: East at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 82°F – 91°F / 28°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 100°F / 36°C – 38°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY 28TH JULY, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern Bahamas: Cloudy to overcast.
Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Northern Bahamas: 40 to 60% chance of showers and thunderstorms.

PRECIPITATION: Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.

WINDS: Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

WINDS: Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 81°F – 88°F / 27°C – 31°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 79°F / 23°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 100°F / 36°C – 38°C

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.

PRECIPITATION: Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of and isolated showers or a thunderstorm.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South-southeast to South-southwest at 10 to 15 knots falling light and variable by evening.

WINDS: Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
