### BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Tuesday, July 15, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

| GENERAL SITUATION:     | Conditions gradually improve across the northern islands as moisture associated<br>with Invest 93L continues to pull north and away from the area. Meanwhile, the<br>Bermuda-Azores High builds westward extending a ridge across the chain of islands.<br>The pressure gradient is expected to strengthen tonight into tomorrow resulting in<br>fresh to occasionally strong surface winds which may help to trigger shower activity<br>and/or isolated thunderstorms, particularly in the northern islands, due to the<br>presence of ample moisture and daytime heating.<br><b>Outlook:</b> A typical summertime pattern will persist into the weekend as high<br>pressure remains dominant. Additionally, expect conditions to remain rather breezy<br>to windy into the weekend as the pressure gradient remains strong across the area.<br>Conditions become more unsettled late Sunday into next week as broad, deep<br>troughing orients itself to the near east of the archipelago. |

| TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: | Florida Peninsula into the Northeastern Gulf (AL93): Satellite and radar<br>data indicate that the low pressure area previously over the Atlantic is<br>moving onto the coast of northeastern Florida. This system is currently<br>producing disorganized shower and thunderstorm activity, and little<br>development is expected through tonight while the center is over land. Once<br>the system reaches the northeastern Gulf on Wednesday, environmental<br>conditions appear generally favorable for additional development, and a<br>tropical depression could form while the system moves across the<br>northeastern and north-central Gulf and approaches the coast of Louisiana<br>on Thursday.<br>Formation chance through 7 days is a medium 40 percent.<br>Elsewhere, tropical cyclone formation is not expected through the next 7<br>days. |
