



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Tuesday, September 22, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A Severe Thunderstorm Watch for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas is in effect from 12am Wednesday 23rd September 2026.

Unsettled conditions will continue across much of the island chain this evening through tonight, fueled by abundant tropical moisture and a persistent upper-level disturbance lingering northwest of the country. By Wednesday, a low- to mid-level disturbance is expected to move northeastward across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, enhancing shower and thunderstorm activity across those areas through Thursday.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: This moist and unstable airmass is expected to persist across the islands through the end of the week, producing showers and thunderstorms mainly across the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas, while the Southeast Bahamas can expect occasional showers. Late Thursday, a cold front is forecast to enter the Northern Bahamas and gradually move southeastward, where it is expected to stall. A drier and more stable airmass will then filter into the northern islands by the weekend.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: There is a *moderate to high* risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms *across* portions of the *Northern and Northwest Bahamas beginning late this evening through tonight.* These storms could produce **strong gusty winds**, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and waterspout activity. Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flooding: There is a *moderate to high* risk of flooding in low-lying and flood-prone areas during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.

Rip Currents: There is a *slight* risk of rip currents impacting the eastern and southern shorelines of the Southeast Bahamas. *Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to exercise caution.*
