BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Tuesday, December 23, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time.
GENERAL SITUATION:	A high pressure system centered over Bermuda will remain the dominant weather feature across the majority of the Bahamas as it gradually shifts into the Central Atlantic. This pattern will generate moderate to fresh breezes, as a few showers persist along a stationary front across the southern island chain. Winds will ease across the islands on Christmas Eve as the front weakens, while a reinforcing cold front approaches just ahead of the Christmas holiday. *Outlook:* A reinforcing cold front is forecast to track along the eastern flank of the islands on
	Christmas and Boxing day with little fanfare. As a result of a drier air mass moving in from the north, rain chances are expected to remain fairly low during this time, with some brief passing showers still possible along those eastern most islands. The pressure gradient will continue to relax across all areas heading into the weekend. Another cold front is anticipated to move into the forecast area by next Tuesday.
SPECIAL	Rip Currents/High and Rough Surf: There is a high risk of dangerous, life threatening rip currents, high seas and rough surf conditions impacting northern, eastern and Atlantic-facing shorelines. Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to refrain from entering the waters in these areas.
WEATHER NOTES:	Coastal Hazards: There remains a risk of minor coastal flooding and beach erosion along northern and eastern coastal areas in the Central and Southeast Bahamas, as well as Atlantic shorelines. Large overtopping waves are possible, and may become hazardous to motorists and pedestrians traversing these areas.
