BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Tuesday, December 9, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There are currently no warnings in effect at this time.
GENERAL SITUATION:	A stationary front positioned across the Northwest Bahamas, along with an associated surface low, will continue to generate showers and very isolated thunderstorms across the Northwest and Central Bahamas through tonight and into early Wednesday. The eastward drift of the surface low on Wednesday will cause the boundary to linger between the Northwest and Central Bahamas, before it is expected to dissipate on Thursday. *Outlook: High pressure will then build, promoting mostly stable and dry conditions across most of the area leading into the weekend, with gentle to moderate breezes.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Flooding: There is a moderate risk of localized flooding during heavy and prolonged rainfall events in the Northwest and portions of the Central Bahamas, especially in low-lying and flood-prone areas. Rip Currents: There is a moderate risk of rip currents mainly along Atlantic exposed shorelines. Therefore, beachgoers and swimmers are advised to remain vigilant.
