BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Tuesday, September 1, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

A **Severe Weather Watch** is now in effect for the entire Bahamas. The public is urged to keep updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

WARNING IN EFFECT: The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has issued an Updated Special Weather Statement regarding the remnants of Dolly and the potential for inclement weather conditions across The Bahamas for this week. Showers and thunderstorm activity will continue over the archipelagic chain due to troughing associated with the remnants of Dolly and troughing saddled across the Northern Bahamas coupled with ample tropical moisture tonight into Wednesday. Meanwhile, high pressure ridging generates gentle to moderate winds over the Northern islands but moderate to locally fresh winds elsewhere. .

GENERAL SITUATION: **Outlook:** An increased flood and severe weather risk exists for the Northern, Northwest and portions of the Central Bahamas beginning midweek, as the wave continues to fuel instability across the area while it travels westwards towards the Gulf. By late Friday, a temporary lull in activity will commence, as high pressure and a drier air mass infiltrates the area heading into the weekend. This cessation of showers and thunderstorms will be short-lived, as moisture and troughing associated with another tropical wave becomes trapped south of a cold front descending off the US east coast on Sunday.

Flood Risk: There is a **moderate** risk for flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall periods, especially over portions of the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas**.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: **Rip Currents:** A **high risk** of rip currents exists along **eastern and southern shorelines of the Central and Southeast Bahamas**, while a **slight to moderate risk** persists elsewhere. **Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to avoid entering the water along eastern and southern shorelines of the Central and Southeast Bahamas, and to exercise caution elsewhere.**

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms tonight increasing 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms during overnight hours into Wednesday.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times tonight becoming Southeasterly at 10 knots or less on Wednesday.
TEMPERATURES: **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **MAXIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms tonight increasing 40 to 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms during overnight hours into Wednesday.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times tonight becoming Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots on Wednesday.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **MINIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A



CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy becoming mostly cloudy overnight into Wednesday.
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms increasing 40 to 60% during overnight hours.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times tonight becoming Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots on Wednesday.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 50% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms possible.
WINDS: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, with occasional gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: **Tropical Storm Edouard:** see the latest news item on tropical storm Edouard located just inland along the Northwestern Gulf coast. (This system poses no threat to The Bahamas.)
Elsewhere, Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next 7 days

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 3RD SEPTEMBER, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Cloudy to occasionally overcast.
Central Bahamas: Partly cloudy.
Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair with a few cloud patches at night.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms, decreasing 20 – 40% by late afternoon. *Showers may become heavy, and thunderstorms severe at times.*
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: **All areas:** Easterly at 15 knots with higher gusts, decreasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair with a few cloud patches at night.
PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 – 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, shifting easterly at 10 knots or less by nightfall.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

SKY CONDITIONS: **All areas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair with a few cloud patches at night.
PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 6TH SEPTEMBER, 2026:

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy.
SKY CONDITIONS: **Central and Southeast Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly to occasionally cloudy by the afternoon hours.
PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 – 40% chance of showers, increasing to a 30 – 50% chance by nightfall.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less.
WINDS: **Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

SKY CONDITIONS: **All areas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less.
WINDS: **Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts, decreasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 74°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A

SKY CONDITIONS: **All areas:** Partly cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms possible.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 knots or less.
WINDS: **Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts in the Southeast Bahamas.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 74°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A
