
WARNING IN EFFECT:	A Wind Advisory and a Gale Warning is in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas until 8pm, but remains in effect across the Central and Southeast Bahamas. Please see our Marine Forecast at met.gov.bs for more information on advisories.
GENERAL SITUATION:	A cold front and its associated trough near the Southeast Bahamas will continue to support some shower and thunderstorm activity across the Central and Southeast Bahamas. Meanwhile, strong high pressure ridging continues to produce breezy and mostly stable conditions over the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. **Outlook:** The frontal boundary will become stationary and remain over the Southeast Bahamas for the rest of the work week, keeping shower and thunderstorm activity elevated over the islands. The robust high pressure will maintain cool, dry and breezy conditions over the island chain into the weekend.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Coastal Hazard: Motorists and pedestrians along northern, eastern and Atlantic shorelines should exercise caution due to the potential for overtopping waves and sea spray, inclusive of the Glass Window Bridge in Eleuthera. Rip Currents: Currently, there is a very high risk of dangerous rip currents across all areas. Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to NOT enter into the water. Coastal Flooding: Due to the full moon and a strong and persistent northerly wind flow, residents particularly on the north coastal areas should be alert for minor flooding along banks, and marshes during high tide.
