BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Tuesday, September 16, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<i>There are currently no public warnings in effect.</i>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>Low level troughing combined with a moist unstable air mass moving across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas will produce convective activity. Expect scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms across the Northern Bahamas beginning late tonight or early tomorrow morning, then spread into the remainder of the islands by mid-day Wednesday.</p> <p>Outlook: An increase in streaming moisture combined with a low to mid-level disturbance will continue to produce a wet weather pattern across the island chain through the end of the work week.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Flooding: There is an elevated chance of flooding in low lying or flood prone areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall events. Therefore, residents are urged to exercise caution.</p> <p>Heat/UV Index: Residents in the Central and Southeast Bahamas are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing, such as wide-brimmed hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen, and to seek shaded areas during peak daylight hours, as a result of heat indices reaching in the upper 90's to lower triple digits, and UV levels in the high to very high range.</p>

PRECIPITATION:	10 - 20% chance of a shower or isolated thunderstorm tonight increasing to 30-40% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms tomorrow.		
WINDS:	Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:	Two areas are currently being monitored:
	1. Central Tropical Atlantic (AL92): A large area of showers and thunderstorms continues to show signs of organization midway between the Windward Islands and the Cabo Verde Islands have become better organized. Environmental conditions are conducive for further development, and a tropical depression or storm is likely to form in the next day or two. Formation chance through 48 hours is high at 90 percent. 2. Eastern Tropical Atlantic: A tropical wave just offshore of the west coast of Africa is producing an area of disorganized showers and thunderstorms. Some slow development of this system is possible towards the latter part of this week. Formation chance through 7 days is low at 20 percent.
