BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Tuesday, July 21, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

A Heat Advisory remains in effect for the Northern Bahamas. Residents and visitors are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing, seek shaded areas and avoid prolonged sun exposure during peak sunshine hours (11am to 4pm).

WARNING IN EFFECT:

High pressure ridging continues to generate moderate winds along with passing showers while weakening and retracting northward. Meanwhile, a deep layered trough will enhance shower and thunderstorm chances over the Southeastern islands late tonight through overnight hours while moving westward.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The deep-layered trough will progressively influence the Bahamas on Wednesday as it continues westward, bringing increased cloud cover along with a higher likelihood of showers and thunderstorms across the island chain. This unsettled weather pattern is expected to expand across the entire country through early Friday, and will persist across the northern territories through to early next week as abundant residual moisture lingers over the area. Gradually improving conditions over the Central and Southeast Bahamas are anticipated this weekend into Monday, ahead of the arrival of a robust tropical wave on Tuesday.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: There is a **moderate risk** of rip currents for the Atlantic and east and southeast coastal waters of the Central and Southeast Bahamas. There is a **slight risk** of rip currents for the Atlantic and east and southeast coastal waters of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. **Swimmers are advised to exercise caution when entering these waters.**

UV Index: On Wednesday, members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (11am to 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** range.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: 40 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 knots, increasing to 10 to 15 knots by the evening hours.
Northwest Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with occasional higher gusts.
Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots ahead of the trough, becoming east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots behind the trough.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

WINDS: Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours.
