	A cold front near the capital continues to push further southeastward with some shower activity along the frontal boundary. Meanwhile, northerly winds and cooler temperatures are expected to persist in the wake of the front.
GENERAL SITUATION:	<i>Outlook:</i> The cold front will continue southeastward across the island chain through the work week, stalling near the Southeast Bahamas by Friday. High pressure will build across the area in wake of the front maintaining cool temperatures and returning a dry, mostly stable weather pattern with gentle to moderate breezes across the islands.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Rip Currents: There is a moderate risk of rip currents impacting Atlantic shorelines therefore beachgoers and swimmers should remain vigilant.
